Valentina Calderai is Associate Professor at the University of Pisa (Department of Law), where she currently teaches Private Law and European Private Law. She is member of the Scientific Board of the PhD Programme in Law (since 2011), Member of the Ethics Committee of the University of Pisa (since 2018), Member of the Administrative Board of the Postgraduate School of Law (since 2016).

Before joining the Department of Law she has been Lecturer (Private Law, Economic Analysis of Law) at the Department of Economics of the University of Pisa (2010-2014) and Max Weber Fellow at the European University Institute (2009-2010).

She holds a five-year Master's degree in Philosophy (with honors) at the University of Urbino, a five years Masters' degree in Law (with honors) from the University of Florence, and a PhD (with honors) from the Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies (Curriculum: Private Law and Comparative Law).

She is the author of a book (*Interpretazione dei contratti e argomentazione giuridica*, Torino: Giappichelli, 2008) and several publications. She is currently writing a book on the impact of the right to self-determination in private law relationships.

She is a Fellow of the European Law Institute (ELI) and a member of the Special Group of Interest (SIG) established by the ELI on European Family and Succession Law.
