M. Dolores Santos Fernández, born in Madrid. Mother of two girls. She graduated in law at Carlos III University in Madrid in June 1996. She is researcher in labor law at the University of Siena since December 30, 2008. She has been a professor of labor law and trade union law at the Faculty of Law at Carlos III University in Madrid, from 1997 to 2003.

She has been a lecturer at "*La libertad femenina en el derecho*" in Duoda, *Centro de Investigación de Mujeres*, of the University of Barcelona. She has been researching at Columbia University in New York, from October to December 1999. She holds a European PhD in labor law at the University of Castilla-La Mancha in December 2003. Post-doctoral researcher at the University of Siena from 2005 to 2008.

She is author of books and numerous essays on Labor Law and Trade Law and has participated in many seminars and conferences on them. In this context, she has worked in research, participation in projects, publications and seminars on various topics, including modernization of working time, double on (at work and maternity) and its implications, the history of the law of Italian and European work, and finally the participation of women in the labor market; her second book, "Derecho, trabajo y diferencia sexual" (2015) is about these topics.
