Angioletta Sperti is Associate Professor of Comparative Public Law at the University of Pisa where she teaches Comparative Constitutional Law and Human Rights Law. Her main research interests include constitutional justice, comparative law, human rights and non-discrimination law.

She graduated cum laude at University of Pisa, holds an LL.M from UCLA (USA) and a PhD cum laude from Scuola S. Anna. She is the author of four monographs on constitutional justice (*Corti supreme e conflitti tra poteri*, 2003), presidential accountability (*La responsabilità del Presidente della Repubblica*, 2010), the dialogue among constitutional courts on LGBT rights (*Omosessualità e diritti*, 2013) and the advancement of LGBT rights (*Constitutional Courts, Gay Rights and Sexual Orientation Equality*, Hart, 2017).

She regularly contributes to *articolo29.it*, a legal website on the advancement of LGBT rights in Italy and is managing editor of GenIUS, an Italian law review on gender and sexual orientation equality.
